ori! Artist: Nicole Meyer-Foresman Shibori is an ancient Japanese dyeing process that involves folding, bunching or twisting material, binding and dunking into a vat of indigo dye. No two pieces will ever be exactly the same. The process is lighthearted and the results are stunning!

Arashi, Kanoko, Itajime, and other techniques will be demonstrated. Each participant will create two tea towels in the Shibori techniques of your choice. Anyone

wanting to wear their Shibori is welcome to bring a white, natural fiber, shirt to dye as well.

# Workshops Available

### • \$35 - Yarn Painting with Neva Rowland

The roots of yarn painting originate in northwestern Mexico with the Huichiol people and the belief that humans are connected to nature and all living things. They accomplished their intricate designs by pressing yarn into natural glue - made from tree resin and beeswax - on a board and left to harden. Modern yarn painting gained popularity in the 70's with New Jersey artist, Robert Gorman. In this class, attendees will sketch their design onto a small canvas board and then glue on their chosen yarn colors to achieve interesting and unique patterns. This art form is a very relaxing way to spend an afternoon!

All materials will be provided. Participants will take their art home when they are finished. Class size limit is 10 people.

### • \$60 - Create your own Ceramic Birdhouse with Daria Claiborne

All supplies are included as well as the firings. Age 16 and up unless accompanied by an adult. Be whimsical, be creative. Time is 2-3 hours.

### • \$50 - Ceramic Sushi Trays with Daria Claiborne

All supplies are included as well as the firings. Age 12 and up unless accompanied by an adult. Don't want sushi? Create a couple of trays that can be used for other things. Time is 2 hours. Make up to four different trays.

### Wood Burning with Ashley Dunham

Three options to choose from.

- 1. \$25 Small wall hanging 2-3 hours and 8 seats available.
- 2. \$20 Bookmark 1-2 hours. 8 seats available
- 3. \$30 Medium Round Wall Hanger cow skull with feathers. 3-4 hours and 8 seats available.

We will be drawing out a design or stencil and then we will use wood burning tools to burn your design in. You will practice first to get the feel for lines and shading. She also has paint pens available if you want to add color. Ashley will add wire to the back so you can hang it on a wall. All projects will be taken home that day.

### **\*Glass Fusing with Dianne Miller**

- \$35 Glass Flowers
- \$35 Small dishes
- \$40 Ornaments (you make 4)
- \$50 Casting Flowers
- \$40 Glass pendants (you make 3)

Participants will learn how to cut glass and design a project that will be kiln-fired and returned within 5-14 days later. Class size ranges from 6-12 people depending on the complexity of the project. Ages 14 and older. Classes last approximately 2 hours. Dianne also offers simple project classes for kiddos ages 6-10 as well.

### \*\$40 - Mosaics for Beginners with Sarah Prince

This is a beginner class for those who want to learn how to do mosaics. We will choose from pre-cut glass, mosaic tiles, beads, sea glass and more to make a gorgeous mosaic feather. All materials are provided. Age Limit 10 - 100 and class size of 14 people. Lasts for 2 hours.

### • \$25 - Pressed Flower Lanterns with Sarah Prince

We will be placing dried flowers onto jars which will turn into candle lanterns. You can stick to one color scheme or add a variety of colors. Feel free to bring your own, sentimental dried flowers as well, but a large variety of dried flowers and all materials will be provided. 14 seats available and for ages 7-107. This takes 2 hours.

Fee is \$25 per jar or \$40 for two jars.

### • \$25 – Tie Dye T-Shirt Party with Sue Hiller Horner

Participants will learn a few tying techniques then, tie their own shirts and apply the dyes and wrap shirt in. Dyes need to set for a minimum of 24 hours. Participants will have the option of taking the shirt with them and following wash out instructions or pick up at the gallery 2 days later. All shirts and materials provided. Ages 12 and up. Limit of 10 people and minimum of 6.
